Pre-Collection

COMMUNICATION TOOLS ESTABLISHED

- Establish Good Mailing List
- Way to Manage and Track Communication (GOS Can Help Clubs with Constant Contact)

HAVE FORMS PRINTED

- Team Collection Sheets (Adds some competition)
- Individual Collection Sheets (Makes Collection Organized)
- Collection Posters For Distribution (The Gift of Soccer Can Customize Posters)

BRAND EXPOSURE

- Add Club Logos to Forms (The Gift of Soccer Can Customize Forms)
- Contact Local Papers and News for Coverage

COLLECTION DATES AND LOCATION

- Establish Time Frames for Families/Teams to Gather Equipment
- Establish Several Ways to Drop Equipment to Organizers (Practice, Games, other)

During Collection

PROMOTE

- Promote Donation Collection as Club Community Event
- Explain the Benefits of Giving Back to Community
- Explain the Benefits of Team Building Off the Field
- Take Pictures of Kids Collecting
- Add Pictures to the Website to Encourage Efforts
- Promote with Newsletters, Twitter & Facebook, Website
- Take Video for YouTube Promotion and Website Footage

Post Collection Events

TALLY

- Count All Collections (Can use Database Tool like Bento, or Excel)
- Take Pictures of Entire Collection with Kids if Possible
- Organize by Sizes and Quality

THANK STAFF/PARTICIPANTS FOR EFFORTS

- Reiterate Donation Collection as Club Community Event
- Add Pictures to Website, Social Media Avenues, and Newsletters
- Contact Local Papers and News for Coverage
- Post Collection Statistics

DISTRIBUTE

- * Team Families on Scholarships or in Need
- * Schools in Area that May Not Have Budgets for Sports
- * Organization & Homeless Shelters that Can Provide Positive Focus Items for Kids
- Expand Outwards & Look in Other Parts of your State or Region
- Send Items Internationally through US Soccer Foundation and EuroSport

PLAN FOR THE NEXT YEAR

Make the Event an Annual Occurrence. Ideally at the Same Time Each Year (So that Parents Know When and Then They Can Plan for It)
